Please read race rules carefully. There is a 48-hr time limit within which to finish the race.

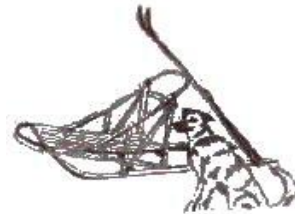
